J24/Sportsboat Duchy Timber Spring Series 2008

NOTICE OF RACE

- 1 The Organising Authority will be the **Saltash Sailing Club**.
- 2 All races will be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association, the class rules of the One Design Classes, this Notice of Race, (except as any of these may be altered by the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.
 - 2.1 The Sailing Instructions will amend the following Racing Rules of sailing:- 29.2, 35, 61.3, A2 & A7.
 - 2.2 All competing boats shall comply with such regulations as may be in force within the Dockyard Port of Plymouth. (Further details of these will be in the Sailing Instructions).
 - 2.3.1 A boat is entirely responsible for its own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.
 - 2.3.2 It is for the boat to decide whether it is fit to sail in the conditions in which it will find itself. By launching or going to sea, the boat confirms that it is fit for those conditions and that its crew is competent to sail and compete in them.
 - 2.3.3 The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims of at least £2m.
 - 2.3.4 Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters.
 - 2.3.5 The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of its responsibilities.
- 3 Racing will be offered for eligible boats in the J24 One Design class and boats with a valid TCS issued by the RORC or the RYA under the Sports Boat Rule 2008.
- 4 The racing area will be Plymouth Sound.
- 5 Schedule of Races:- Saturdays 5 April, 12 April, 19 April and 26 April. The 1st Warning Signal will be made at 1410 each day
- 6 Two races are scheduled for each Saturday. Races will be of windward/leeward courses configuration.
- 7 Entries shall be made on a standard SSC Entry Form, accompanied by the Entry Fee.
- 8 Entry fees :- Sportsboats and J24 OD £6 per race £20 series
- 9 Prizes:- Bottle and other prizes down to 3rd Place each week, Series prizes to 3rd for each class subject to sufficient entries.
- 10 Sailing Instructions will not be sent to competitors but will be issued on receipt of entry.
